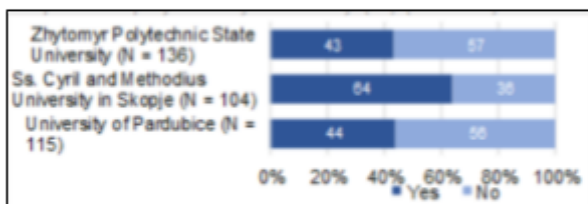

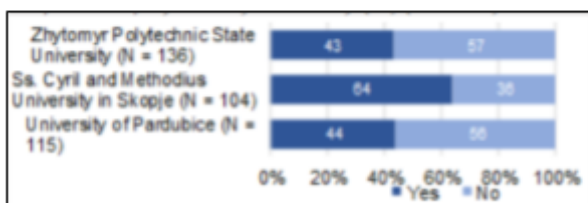
Questionnaire Report:

Analysis of the needs, requirements, and expectations of target groups

Wide AcrossEU conducted a questionnaire survey to map the need for academic and non-academic training, as well as to evaluate the current system of project support.

The results highlight key areas where additional support is needed. It has revealed that there remains a strong interest in further training and support opportunities.

Respondents expressed a preference for online training formats, followed by short-term stays.

The most sought-after skills include:

- training for technical aspects of the project application (51%)
- project budget planning (50%).
- funding project applications and conditions for funding (40%):
- technical/administrative support for project changes, and organisational commitments, e.g. Letters of Intent/Support (40%)
